Dear Parents and Carers,

I have been struck by the positive attitude and cheer of all our returning children over the past few weeks. Well done to all the children and to all our families for finding a way to cope with the lockdown; adapt to home learning; and keep a positive outlook at this extremely difficult time for all. Our mission statement of growing together in love and learning has certainly been challenged over the past few months and I hope you feel, as we do, that we have stayed together and in many ways grown in strength as a community. Communication and thought for others has been the key as we hold to our Christian values. It has been a change for all of us and I would like to mention all of our staff who have shown great dedication to the school community alongside all our families.
