Maths:

- Set on a Monday and due in on a Thursday. This should take up to 45mins.
- From October half term my Maths will also be set weekly.

English:

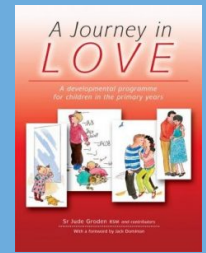
- Set on a Friday and due in on a Monday. This should take up to an hour.
- Homework will have a focus on grammar and reading comprehension.
- Once a half term, Homework will focus on RE or Topic research.
- Spellings and times tables to be practised (encourage children to do this every night).

We are working towards using Google Classroom to set homework.

- We will sign it when we have read it.

PSCHE:



- We will be following the scheme called 'A Journey in Love'.

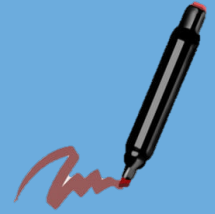
PE:

- **Tickled pink/Green for growth**

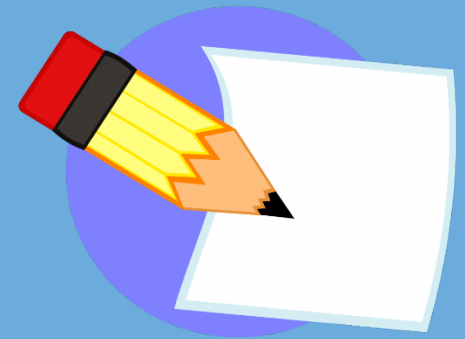
Children are encouraged to self assess, self mark and peer mark.
