Children will be invited to come into school with Autumn coloured accessories (but still in school uniform) such as an Autumn coloured jumper, socks/tights or hair accessories. Any donations will be via the school gateway but we hope that children will be able to raise the money themselves – maybe by doing jobs at home or outside. School Council

Year 5&6 should come in school uniform and will change later as they are running in the afternoon. Please note for Year 3 that the coach will be leaving promptly straight after registration.

This is a great event. If your child is not an enthusiastic runner they are still asked to take part but jog at their own pace. For keen runners, there will be nominations for regional finals.
